Board of Regents

- The Board of Regents, at its meeting on August 20, 2008, approved the establishment of a collaborative/franchise agreement to offer a Master of Arts in Teaching (in an online format) with certification options in mathematics, biology, chemistry, physics, and earth/space science. Initially, Columbus State University, Kennesaw State University, and the University of West Georgia are selected as home institutions and will thus grant the degree. Furthermore, Georgia Southern University and Valdosta State University will offer courses and become degree providers by 2010.
