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What is Curriculog?

Curriculog is Kennesaw State University's online curriculum management solution. Through this system, the curriculum management process is entirely online, including curriculum proposals, meeting agendas, and reviews and decisions made by committees and administrators.

Curriculog is tied directly to the university's online catalog database, Acalog. Through this integration, users are able to pull information from the active catalog directly into curriculum proposals for review and modification.

Prior to gaining access to Curriculog, you must complete training for your user role (proposal originator, curriculum committee chair/faculty administrator, and/or curriculum committee member).

How can I gain access to Curriculog?

Before you are able to perform any task in Curriculog, you must first complete the appropriate online module(s) for the roles you will have in the system. These modules can be found on the Campus Training site at <https://campustraining.kennesaw.edu/login/index.php>.

Once you have completed training, you must obtain a PIN by contacting us at curriculog@kennesaw.edu.

That's all there is to it! From this point forward you will have permissions for whatever level(s) of training you have completed.
